## **NEWSLETTER No. 1**

The project "Adaptation of modern didactic methods for instructors in the flour products manufacturing sector through flexible learning paths specific to adult training" has as its main objective the development of skills for 40 expert staff trainers, employed at the employer's organization and member units through the mobilities carried out in the 2 partner countries – Italy and Ireland.

It is thus desired that the mobility activities achieve the two specific objectives:

- the development of professional skills in the field of flour products manufacturing technologies for 40 participants through an exchange of best practices
- the development of professional skills in the field of communication to the final consumer of information regarding the consumption of flour products according to the nutritional needs of each one for 40 participants through mobility.

The purpose of the mobility is to develop the specialized technical skills according to the Nutrition Technician SPP - Food principles and nutritional value, so that later they can introduce the range of products they received information about during the trip to the units from which they come.

Within the project there will be two categories of participants:

- A category consisting of 10 expert personal trainers employees of ROMPAN
- A category consisting of 30 expert personnel instructors employees of the 200 ROMPAN member units who have direct activity related to the technological process.

A mandatory condition is that all participants have specialized higher education, trainer competence and have specific attributions for staff training.

The 10 participants from ROMPAN will participate both in mobility at the Italian partner - AGRIS SARDEGNA (Mentor: Margherita Addis) and at the one in Ireland - KERRY INGREDIENTS (Mentor: Andreea Bonis).

The other 30 participants from ROMPAN member units will form two groups of 15 people each, and each person will participate in a 4-day mobility in Italy or Ireland.
